AGENDA 1 Discussion on the Process to Enter the Second Cycle of NAAC Accreditation

IQAC Co-ordinator discussed the importance of NAAC accreditation and how it positively impacts the institution's reputation, funding opportunities, and overall quality of education. shared a presentation detailing the key steps and requirements for the second cycle of NAAC accreditation. This included the submission of a self-study report, data collection, assessment, and peer team visits. She also emphasized the need for active participation from all departments and stakeholders, and the importance of transparency and clear communication throughout the process.

AGENDA 2: Discussion on Prerequisites for Filling the IIQA (Institutional Information for Quality Assessment) Form Online under NAAC Accreditation

The IQAC Co-ordinator provided a brief overview of the IIQA form and its significance in the accreditation process. She emphasized the need for accurate and comprehensive data submission. The attendees of the meeting discussed the importance of IIQA in evaluating the institution's readiness for NAAC accreditation and the role it plays in subsequent peer team visits. IQAC Co-ordinator presented a step-by-step guide on how to access and fill the IIQA form online. This included information on the online portal, login credentials, and the deadline for submission. The group discussed the prerequisites for filling the IIQA form, which included gathering data related to infrastructure, faculty, courses, research, publications, and various institutional activities. stressed the need for a dedicated team or point person to oversee the IIQA submission process, ensuring that the information is accurate, up-to-date, and aligns with the institution's goals.

AGENDA 3: Yoga session on International Yoga Day

Dr. Prof. Sheetal Saxena, HOD, Community Health Nursing Dept discussed organizing a yoga session on International Yoga Day in collaboration with SBPASS to foster the holistic development of undergraduate students. The session is finalized to be held on 21st June 2023.

AGENDA 4: District Level NSS orientation Program

Prof. Rakhi Chandel, NSS Co-Ordinator discuss about the planning of organizing a comprehensive District Level NSS Orientation Program tailored for Program Officers. The program is strategically designed to encompass key areas crucial for the successful implementation of National Service Scheme (NSS) initiatives at the district level. A primary focus will be placed on understanding the local context, ensuring that program officers are well-versed in the social, economic, and cultural nuances of the communities they serve. This understanding forms the bedrock for tailoring NSS activities to the specific needs of the community. Additionally, the program will delve into effective strategies for community engagement and collaboration, emphasizing the importance of building sustainable partnerships with local stakeholders, authorities, and organizations. Recognizing the pivotal role of NSS volunteers, the orientation will also include intensive training and capacity-building sessions for program officers, ensuring they possess the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively guide and support volunteers in their respective districts.
